The withdrawal deadline is Thursday, 12:00 Noon on February 22, 2018, and the last day to register to vote, both in person and by-mail with a postmark or online is Monday, April 2, 2018.

Photo ID Required for In-Person Voting

During early voting and on Election Day, all voters must present a Federal or State of Tennessee government issued photo ID, unless an exception applies. The ID must contain the voter's name and photograph. College student IDs are not accepted.
